Agency Financial Report

Approved FY21 Agency

Ms. Mok updated the Commission regarding the FY 2020 budget for the period of July 1, 2019 to June 24, 2020 in victim payments. The beginning budget is \$2,620,585, with a total amount for victim payouts to date of \$2,678,859. At the current rate of expenses in victim payouts, the agency projects to utilize \$52,446 from Crime Victim Fund balance to cover the payouts through the end of the fiscal year.

Ms. Mok also updated the Commission about the current status of Crime Victims Fund. The breakdown of the payments received for the period of July 1, 2019 to June 24, 2020 in Crime Victims Fund by type:

Restitution: \$54,123.00 Corrections: \$428,590.00 Civil Settlement: \$7,784.00 Penalty Assessment: \$303,337.00

Total received: \$793,835.00

New Business

Approved FY21 Agency Budget

Ms. Mok presented to the Commission an overview for the approved FY 2021 budget. Ms. Mok stated the the special session House Bill 1 impacted all state agency budgets and includes a 4% budget cut in state fiscal year 2021, with a possibility of additional cuts in the next legislative session. Due to statewide budget cuts, HB 1 removed the proposed 4% pay increase for all state employees July 1, 2020.

Business

Grants Update (VOCA, VAWA, SASP, and State)

Ms. Garcia, Grants Bureau Chief, informed the Commission of the following:

The Grants Department continues to hold weekly zoom meetings to facilitate immediate access to resources, best practices and trauma informed services during the COVID-10 health pandemic. This included four (4) zoom gatherings per week.

The Grants Bureau Chief has participated in the national weekly calls with the Office on Violence Against Women to address concerns related to the COVID 19 crisis.

Commission Meeting Minutes

June 25, 2020

The match waiver notifications have been sent to subrecipients for the six-month period of FFY2020.

The Grants Bureau Chief has been participating in a working group with Children, Youth and Families, the New Mexico Coalition Against Domestic Violence and the Coalition to Stop Violence Against Native Women as the statewide domestic violence service definition manual.

The VOCA VA continuation cycle timeline is being prepared and will be sent out to subrecipients for FFY2021.

All FY2021 state grants have been prepared and are being routed for signatures for a July 1st start date.

The FY2020 OVC VOCA VA continuation application was submitted on May 26, 2020.

The Office for Victims of Crime Performance Management Data for first quarter was reviewed and corrections made by agencies, per the request of OVC PMT. Agencies have submitted their second quarter data, which was due May 31, 2020. The data is being reviewed and will be submitted by July 15, 2020.
